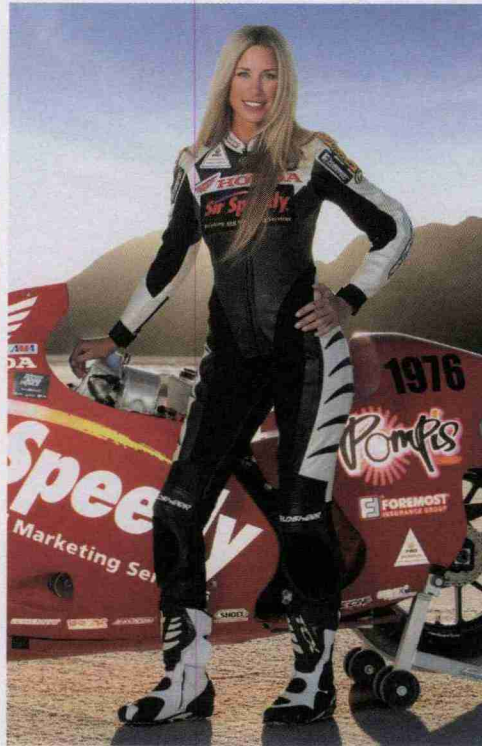


Sir, you're one speedy lady

What better way to tell the world your printing and copying services live up to its name—Sir Speedy—than to sponsor the “fastest woman in the world on two wheels”?

Leslie Porterfield, the woman who holds that title, along with a Guinness World Record for reaching 232.5 mph on a motorcycle in 2008, has been an attractive draw for the franchise.

This September, on an unmodified Honda CBR1000, she was clocked at an average of 200.137 mph.
